

Garden Share Scheme

Been waiting years for an allotment? Ever seen an unused garden and wished you could grow your own vegetables there? Or do you have a garden or area of land that you would like to see used more productively? A Garden Share scheme would help remedy this.

The Chesterford garden Share scheme would match owners of land (e.g. People with larger gardens who wouldn't mind allowing someone to grow vegetables in a small area, or an elderly person who is no longer able to look after their garden), with committed, enthusiastic and respectful vegetable growers.

The benefits for the garden owner would be:

- **A share of the produce (typically one fifth to a quarter)**
- **The pleasure of seeing a developing vegetable plot**
- **Being part of a sharing initiative.**
- **A sense of community**
