Message from Essex Police Thursday May 6th, 2010.

Catalytic Converter theft

At Cage End, Hatfield Broad Oak between 30th April– Tuesday 4th May. Removed from a Ford Transit by cutting. This has likely occurred during a spate of other recent similar offences either overnight Friday 30th April or Saturday 1st May.

Vehicle theft Wed 28th April

At around 4pm on wed 28th April a White Vauxhall Combo Van was stolen from High Easterbury Farm, High Easter. The van was parked at the front of the farm visible from the main road. If you saw anyone behaving suspiciously around this area at the time, please let us know.

Suspicious vehicle

Ford Escort van white S355 DPP behaving extremely suspiciously in Epping. Van was parked outside farm premises. Subsequently occupants were seen emerging from the farm. Nothing has been reported stolen, but there is a good chance that these people were up to no good. Please let us know immediately if you see this van in any suspicious circumstances whatsoever.

At a farm in Down Hall Road, Matching, Harlow, CM17 0RB, a commercial tenant reported that a white Transit type of open backed truck, vehicle reg no: P450GMM has been acting suspiciously, and contained 2 white males. The transit driver noticed that the tenants were leaving Stone Hall Business Park with 3 trucks loaded with metal racking and followed the tenants. The tenants report that Transit reversed away from their unit entrance when approached.
