POLICE INCIDENT REPORT

North Uttlesford

Attempted theft at Newport Train Station car park Thurs 6th May

2 males with (cutting) torches were reported as attempting to break into the car park meter at the train station. The suspects were wearing dark clothing and masks and were driving a black Escort or similar vehicle. If you saw anything suspicious around this area on Thursday evening at around 11pm, please let us know.

Suspicious vehicle in Great Chesterford Thurs 6th May

A white open backed transit van P559DUK has been seen driving slowly around properties in Great Chesterford. As there have been several metal thefts in the area recently, please be on the lookout for any vehicles behaving suspiciously and call us if you have any concerns whatsoever.

Vehicle theft, Waitrose car park, Saffron Walden – Wed 5th May

A green Vauxhall Astra was stolen from the Waitrose car park between 2.15pm – 2.35pm. If you saw anything unusual in the car park between these times, please get in touch.

Mower theft, Little Sampford – Tues 4th May

A "Lawn Flite" ride on mower has been removed from a garden in Hawkins Hill on Tues 4th May between 6.30am and 7pm. The mower is red in colour and rusty at the front.

Metal theft, Farmadine, Saffron Walden – 3rd May overnight

2 cast iron columns have been removed from a driveway between 11.30pm on 3rd May – 2pm 4th May. Previously, a male had enquired about buying the columns for scrap metal, but when the owner declined the male became rude. This male was between 45-50 years old, heavy build with a local accent and driving a battered white transit van.

Vehicle theft – Horn Book, Saffron Walden – 1st – 3rd May

A blue Peugeot 307 has been stolen from Horn Book.

Burglary at Saffron Walden Cricket Club-house Sun 2nd May

Between 4.15pm and 10.30pm, the club house at the Cricket Club was broken into by breaking shutters and smashing windows. A small amount of bottled beer was stolen but the damage to the windows is significant. Club members came across youths earlier in the day attempting to interfere with the windows and a full description has been give to the Police.

Attempted burglary, Langley Lower Green Sunday 2nd May

A householder discovered two individuals attempting to break into her property whilst she and her family were at home at around 2am.

Newport, Criminal damage at garden centre – Fri 30th April overnight

At some point during the night, a large concrete great dane statue was pushed over and smashed.
