POLICE INCIDENT REPORT Wednesday 7th July 2010 – North Uttlesford

Theft of manhole covers - Debden Road, 2nd July overnight

Between 6pm on Friday night and 8am on Saturday, man hole covers were stolen from Debden Road.

Garage burglary Friday 2nd July - Wimbish

Tools have been stolen from a garage in Top Road, Wimbish. The garage was left unlocked between 3pm – 6pm whilst the owner was working in the house. Essex Police would strongly advise that ALL sheds, garages and outhouses are kept locked when not being used.

Theft at St Marys Church, Little Sampford Friday 2nd July 2:15pm – 5pm

An unknown person/s has entered the open Church at Little Sampford, and removed cash from the collection box. It is believed that the box contained only a very small amount of change.

Chrishall - Holy Trinity Church, Friday 2nd July

An attempt appears to have been made to steal a strimmer from Chrishall Church on the afternoon of Friday 2 July at around 4.30pm. A man was found with the strimmer in his car - a darkish blue small Rover / Allegro with registration number P946 MTW.

When challenged, he stated that he had borrowed it and was now returning it. He then unloaded the strimmer and left it outside the church. The witness then entered the church to see if everything was in order, to discover that the cash in the collection tray had been stolen. By the time the witness came back outside, the suspect had left.

The man is described as being around 5' 8" tall, with dark hair and a pink "sweaty" complexion. If you see this man, please call us.

Index plates stolen at Station Rd, Saffron Walden 1st - 2nd July

Both front and rear index plates have been removed from a red Volkswagen Golf on Station Rd overnight on Thursday 1st July.

Please ensure that any index plate thefts are reported to the Police, since these plates may be used illegally either on stolen cars or on vehicles being used in criminal activity.

Criminal Damage at Radwinter Rd Cemetery 7th June - 2nd July

Theft of items and damage has been caused to two graves at the cemetery at Radwinter Rd. If you ever see anybody behaving suspiciously or inappropriately at the cemetery, please call in at once.

Criminal damage, Little Walden Rd - overnight 5th July between 10pm – 2am

Several cars on Little Walden were pelted with eggs causing both mess and scratching to the paintwork of the cars. If you saw anything unusual on Little Walden Rd between these times, please get in touch.

Criminal damage – Cromwell Rd - overnight 5th July

The front tyre of a minibus has been cut with a sharp implement causing an indentation to the tyre and making it unsafe to drive.

Metal thefts

In response to recent manhole cover and cable thefts, please can you ask that you call Essex Police on 999 if you see people working on rural roads overnight without any clear identification on their vehicles or clothing, or otherwise behaving suspiciously in any way at all. We can then investigate whether they are legitimate or not. The Police would rather attend and discover that all is in order than not be called at all, so please DO call us.
