What Can You Do?

The application is due to go to Appeal in February. We estimate that the total cost of organising our defence could be between £60,000 and £80,000. This is made up of costs for a legal team comprising a barrister and a solicitor, and also employing expert witnesses to give their professional statements on the key issues such as landscape, noise, and human and animal welfare.

Wind developers are funded by investors on the strength of the huge guaranteed returns from indirect subsidies paid for wind-generated electricity. These hidden subsidies are paid from your electricity bills and are a major cause of the rapid rise in electricity prices.

We are wholly dependent on donations from ordinary people.

Although you may have heard that there has been a second reading of a draft Bill in the House of Commons designed to protect people from developments too close to habitation, it is unlikely this Bill will be enacted before the Inspector's decision on this wind farm. Our only ability to defend ourselves is through the Action Group and in co-operation with the local Councils.

The quality of the case we make at the Inquiry is directly dependent on the funds we raise. The more money we raise the better we will be able to represent your interests. So we are asking you to dig deep to help us fight this perverse appeal.
